ORDER

The Director, Department of Youth Welfare vide the letter read above has informed that the 30th South Zone Inter University Youth Festival, sponsored by AIU and Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India is scheduled to be held from 8th to 12th December 2014 at Tumkur University, Karnataka and that the Department is planning to conduct selection process for various events during 18th to 26th September 2014 in the Thrikkakara campus. The Director has requested to permit him to conduct the selection process from 18th to 26th September 2014 and to sanction an advance of ₹ 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) for meeting the expenditure of the selection process.

Having considered the request, sanction is accorded by the Pro-Vice-Chancellor in-charge of the Vice-Chancellor to the Director, Department of Youth Welfare to draw an advance of ₹ 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) for meeting the expenditure in connection with the selection process to the 30th South Zone Inter University Youth Festival, subject to the condition that the selection will be done as per the U.O. read as (2). The breakup of the advance sanctioned is as follows:

The expenditure on this account shall be met from the Head of Account "2-09-0-Q-3-202 Youth Festival" provided for in the budget estimates of the University.

The advance drawn shall be adjusted according to the following conditions:

- A time limit of 3 months is fixed for the presentation of final bill.
- In cases where temporary advance is not utilized fully but the adjustment bill is submitted in time, interest at the rate of 18% per annum will be charged on the unutilized portion of the advance from the date of drawal to the date of refund of advance.

- In cases where the adjustment bill is not submitted within the prescribed time, the entire amount of advance may be recovered in one lump immediately on the expiry of such time limit. Interest at the rate of 18% will be charged in the entire amount of advance from the date of drawal to the date of recovery of the amount.
